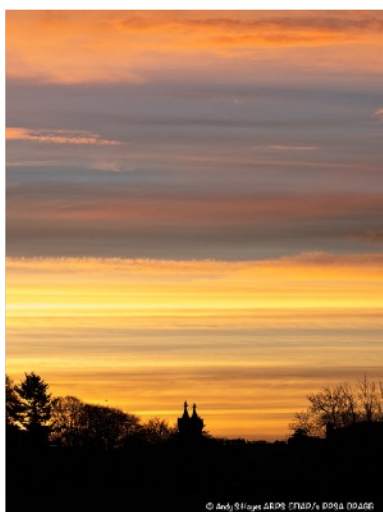


## GDPR REGULATIONS
