# SPF Roll of Honour Regulations

This honour is awarded to a person belonging to a member club of the Scottish Photographic Federation who has given exceptional service to club photography in Scotland.

## Qualification for the award

The nominee must have given his / her services to helping club photography within the Federation or the Federation itself over a minimum of 15 years by for example judging, lecturing, running a national/international event or having given exceptional service to his/her club(s) and / or the Federation.

# Regulations

## 1. Nomination

- 1.1 Any member of the Federation whether as an individual, or on behalf of a club may make a nomination.
- 1.2 The nomination must be treated at all times as strictly confidential and not be made known to the nominee until decided by the Awards Committee and the Executive informed.
- 1.3 The nomination should be submitted in writing to the President as Chairman of the Awards Committee.
- 1.4 The nomination must be accompanied by a) a statement describing the nominee's service, and b) evidence of the service, e.g. Judges and Lecturers list, club lists of office bearers and indications of relevant time-scales and dates.
- 1.5 The nominator must supply the names and addresses of 2 independent referees who will be willing to provide supporting evidence if requested.

#### 2. Consideration

- 2.1 The Awards Committee will comprise the current President, Senior and Junior Vice Presidents.
- 2.2 Applications will be considered by the Awards Committee within 2 months.

# 3. Announcement

3.1 Decisions on nominations shall be notified to the next Executive meeting and the nominee, nominator and club secretary shall be informed in writing as appropriate.

# 4. Recognition

- 4.1 A certificate recognising the Award shall be given to the recipient.
- 4.2 The recipient will be listed on the future Roll of Honour and will be permitted to display Hon SPF after his/her name. The Roll of Honour will be published in all official SPF publications.
- **4.3** The Award should be presented by the President at the next SPF held event where the recipient is present or other suitable occasion.

# Notes for guidance for the Awards Committee.

Regulation 1.4 – the 15 year qualifying period need not be continuous if the Awards Committee adjudges sufficient reason(s) exist for a break in service to the Federation or Club Photography.

Regulation 2.1 – the Executive may agree to alter the composition of the Awards Committee in an emergency.

Regulation 2.2 – it is expected that the approval of an award by the Awards Committee will be by a consensus rather than a majority vote.

Regulation 3.1 - if the nomination is rejected, then only the nominator should be informed with an explanation: a pro forma shall be prepared for signature by the President.

Regulation 4.3 – where expedient the Senior or Junior Vice President may make the presentation: a suitable club event may be an AGM, dinner or inter-club activity.
