TWO SPONSORS AND TWO IMPORTANT CLUB AWARDS

ONLINE PAPER OF GREET GREET SPECIALISTS OF GREET SPECIALISTS

This award is designed to recognise the Club who makes the most effort to support the MASTERS ?F PRINT and will be calculated as 1 point for each print submitted plus the average score per print multiplied by 10.



DIAM?ND CLUB AWARD

This award is designed to recognise the most successful Club in the MASTERS **?**F PRINT and will be calculated by the average score per print multiplied by 10 plus 10 points for each Print accepted to the exhibition.



Scottish Photographers did extremely well in the 6TH MASTERS 9F PRINT. Of the final 60 works chosen for the exhibition, no fewer than 10 were from Scottish authors.

The Scottish Photographic Federation was the 3rd most successful Federation overall, with 44 photographers from 8 SPF Clubs -; Eastwood, Bon Accord, Kirkcaldy, Oban, Edinburgh, Dumfries, Ayr and Dundee. Two SPF Clubs finished in the top ten – Ayr and Dumfries. Top Scottish Club was Dumfries CC who entered 59 prints and came 3rd overall; 8th place went to Ayr PS who entered 25 prints, Kirkcaldy PS who entered 27 prints finished a very creditable

13th place, just missing out on the top 10 by 3 points.

Congratulations go to the following successful Scottish authors who gained acceptances – Kirsten Bax, Ian Mitchell, Maybeth Jamieson, Gordon Rae, Martin Watt, Rikki O'Neill, David Moyes, Ruth Hayton, Margaret Elliot and Michele Campbell.

Further congratulations to David Moyes who won a PAGB Silver Medal for one of the Judges Choices with his print 'The Eye'.



How to enter the MASTERS ?F PRINT (M?P)

This event allows you to enter as an Individual or you can organise an entry on behalf of your Club. You should be a bona fide member of a Club affiliated to the PAGB (which all SPF member Clubs are) but you may only enter for one Club each year.

For the timetable for the competition (click here)

Entries, either by an Individual or by a Club, must be made through the PAGB on-line Entries System. This includes PDI copies of your prints 2400 pixels on the longest side.

The system provides a download of labels, with barcodes, which must be fixed to the back of each Print. When viewed from the back, the label should be placed as close as possible to the top right corner. In addition to the Print labels, the system provides a download of documentation to be sent to the Organisers with the Prints. You enter via the PAGB CES Website which will require you to register as an Individual and/or as a Club if you are not already registered. (click here)

60 Prints are then selected for the Exhibition (max one per author), and awards are made to individual prints. In addition to this, every entrant receives a copy of this year's superb "coffee table" photobook featuring all of the Accepted photographs, one per page.

Successful entrants, on signature of the archive photobooks, receive a unique bronze badge, a real symbol of honour and, on acceptance to a fifth M?P, they receive a silver version of the same badge. You too could secure one of these badges and, like other recipients, wear it with pride at photographic events.

Also, there are many valuable prizes given to pictures chosen by our Sponsors from the exhibition. Paper, printers, cameras, and valuable gift vouchers have been presented. What might YOU win this year?

Entry as an Individual - A maximum of 5 prints may be entered, divided amongst the three Categories in any way. The fee for an Individual entry is £15.

Entry by a Club - The Club may collate the work of any number of Photographers, excluding anyone who has entered as an Individual. A maximum of 5 prints per Photographer may be entered, divided amongst the Categories in any way. The fee for a Club entry is £3 per print with a minimum Club Fee of £15.



Club Awards - Club Entrants and Individual Entrants will each accrue points towards their Club score for a chance to win two generous Club Awards, each with a handsome trophy provided by our primary sponsors, Online Paper and CEWE.

The SPF Digital Inter-Club Championship 2023 is back as an audience event.

The Judging will be held on Sunday 19th November 2023 at our new venue the Victoria Hall, Dunblane and all Club members are welcome to attend whether or not your Club has made an

entry, so please put this date in your diary.

Tea/coffee and biscuits will be available and is included in your admission ticket price of £8.00, payable cash on the door, on the day, so please make sure you have change - No pre-booking required.

There is no other catering available at the venue but there are local vendors close by including coffee shops and pubs, or you can bring your own packed lunch, which you are welcome to eat in the side room, set up for hospitality on the day.

Our 2023 event has a new format and more Individual Awards to be won than in previous years! The Championship 2023 will be run as two separate competitions, both run on the same day, judged by three Judges. Your Club should choose which Competition to enter. Either 'The Plate Competition' or 'The Bowie Competition'. You cannot enter both. This new format reflects features of both the 'Interim' and the 'Normal' Digital Championship events and is designed to meet the needs of all of our SPF Clubs.

PAGB Inter-Federation Competitions

This year the PAGB Inter-Federation Competition Judging was open to Prints only with Three Sections being Judged - Colour, Mono and Nature - where up to 30 prints per section could be submitted by each Federation, with the top scoring 15 counting to the overall Federation score.

The SPF chose our entry largely from the delayed SPF 2023 Print Championship, and we are very grateful for the Clubs and Individual Photographers who gave us their permission to use, together with additional prints submitted for possible selection.

A total of 1150 prints were entered by the PAGB Federations, so it was quite an achievement to gain an acceptance in the Exhibition.


The SPF finished 5th in the Colour Print Section, 9th in the Nature Print Section and an excellent 2nd in the Mono Print Section.

The Judges were Jenny Hibbert (WPF), Roger Parry (MCPF) and Nick Hilton (L&CPU). The Judging was hosted by the L&CPU and was run as a closed event in early June.

- In the Mono Print Section We had 7 Acceptances by Michele Campbell, Ayr PS; Alistair Cox and Libby Smith Carluke CC; David Moyes, Dumfries CC; David Reid and Eion Johnston, Edinburgh PS; Stan Farrow, St Andrews PS.
- In the Colour Print Section We had 5 Acceptances by Alistair Cox and Gaille Gray, Carluke CC; Maybeth Jamieson, Dumfries CC; Wanda Mackie, Kirkcaldy PS; Kenny Gordon, Eastwood PS.
- In the Nature Print Section We had 3 Acceptances by Alistair Swan, Ayr PS; Ian Mitchell, Bon Accord CC; Richard Bennett, PCPC.

Congratulations go to those authors, and also to these Individual Award winners from the SPF -

- In the Mono Print Section A Judge's Award went to Eion Johnston, Edinburgh PS for 'Consoling Touch'; a PAGB Ribbon went to David Reid, Edinburgh PS for 'Only Pride was Hurt'; a Certificate went to Alistair Cox, Carluke CC for 'Scarlot's Leap'.
- In the Colour Print Section A PAGB Ribbon went to Maybeth Jamieson, Dumfries for 'Round Up'; a PAGB Ribbon also went to Kenny Gordon, Eastwood PS for 'Stranded'.
- In the Nature Print Section A PAGB Ribbon went to Richard Bennett, PCPC for 'Arctic Fox in Blizzard'.
