SPF Clubs, and Individuals have again done well in the 7th PAGB Masters of Print, with the following SPF authors all gaining one of the coveted limited 60 acceptances on offer - Alan Givens, Kirkcaldy; Anne Greiner, Dumfries; Lorna Hayton, Ayr; Peter Lawrie, CKPS; Wanda Mackie, Kirkcaldy; Teresa Mitchell, Dumfries; Rikki O'Neill, Dundee; George Robertson, Scottish Circle; Keith Thorburn, Edinburgh; Martin Watt, Kirkcaldy and Maybeth Jamieson, Dumfries. Maybeth doing so for a record 7th time, one of only 3 photographers to do so. We'll bring you all of their exhibited prints in the next issue, and a dedicated SPF webpage will appear very soon for the 7th MoP!

SPF Clubs also did well in the Club Awards

Kirkcaldy finishing 3rd, and Dumfries 4th in the new CeWe Diamond award (Dundee 13th, Scottish Circle 17th, CKPS 19th, Ayr 21st). The Scottish Circle finished 3rd in the Online Paper Gold Award, Dumfries 4th, Dundee 9th, Kirkcaldy 11th and Ayr 17th.

All of our SPF Judges and Lecturers are listed. – PAGB Recorded Lecture Service – Competition Entry and Results area – Catalogues to view of past competitions.

You use the same log-in as you would to enter a competition or upload your PAGB Awards Adjudication submission, you only need to ensure you log-in and register as a Club Officer (Committee Member) of your Club.
