The venue is our normal venue Victoria Hall, Stirling Road, Dunblane FK15 9EX.



Interested in Applying for a FIAP Distinction?

All applications being made to the SPF for submission to FIAP in June 2025 must be made between the 1st March and 15th May. If you miss this deadline you won't be able to apply until 2026.

Any SPF Club member is eligible to apply provided they live in Scotland. You require to have entered Salons or Exhibition who have FIAP Patronage and gained the required number of acceptances.

New paperwork FOR 2025 is now available from the SPF website.

Quantities have not changed for 2025 but there are changes to the application process which should aid the process for everyone.

You now require to request your personal copy of the current FIAP Salon File in advance of applying.

This will allow you to check the accuracy of your excel file prior to submission to the SPF, this is mandatory. (Salon Files available soon request your copy now.)

Please also remember you require to have a current FIAP Photographer's Card before you can apply, you can do so now following the information given on the below SPF webpage.

Edinburgh Photographic Society is pleased to announce that the 161st Edinburgh International Photography Exhibition is now open for entry.




