Interested in Applying for a FIAP Distinction? Deadline for receipt of Applications 15th May

All applications being made to the SPF for submission to FIAP in June 2025 must be made by 15th May. If you miss this deadline, you won't be able to apply until 2026.

Any SPF Club member is eligible to apply provided they live in Scotland. You require to have entered Salons or Exhibition who have FIAP Patronage and gained the required number of acceptances.

SCOTTISH SUCCESSES

AT THE PAGB AWARDS FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC MERIT APR 2025, AT DUNBLANE







The Scottish Photographic Federation were delighted to host the PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit on Saturday and Sunday 26th & 27th April 2025 at our now regular venue of Victoria Hall, Dunblane. We had 30 Scottish photographers in for this adjudication, with applications at all five levels, BPAGB, CPAGB, DPAGB, EPAGB and MPAGB. This was largely due to the numerous SPF workshops and zoom presentations we have held over the past 18 months.

Out of the 67 successful applicants over the two days just over a third of those came from Scottish entrants with 24 successful SPF photographers, and most of them made it along on the day - A tremendous achievement! There were successes at all five levels, and all in the Print sections - 3 BPAGB - 9 CPAGB - 8 DPAGB - 2 EPAGB and 2 MPAGB. Congratulations to them all.
