AYR PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY FINISH THIRD AT PAGB WARWICK

The 2025 PAGB Inter-Club Projected Digital Championship was held on 6th July. This event was once again held at Warwick School, Myton Road. Three Scottish Clubs made the trip to represent the SPF; Dumfries CC who made last year's final, along with Ayr PS and Edinburgh PS who qualified in November's SPF Digital Championship. This year's Judges were Paul Stanley (IPF), Paul Radden (EAF) and Barbara Jenkin (WCPF).

The 37 Clubs entered this year's competition, from the PAGB Federations, and competed in the first and second rounds for a place in the final. The competition was keenly fought with 8 Clubs qualifying for the final. At the end of the first two rounds, Ayr had qualified for the Final, while Dumfries and Edinburgh competed for the Plate trophy.

The final Plate results were to see the scores incredibly close. Edinburgh PS finish in 8th place with 96 pts and Dumfries CC finished in 13th= place on 94 pts.

In the Final, Ayr PS were to finish in a fantastic 3rd place on 247 pts behind joint winners Rolls Royce Derby and Chorley PS on 256 pts. A large contingent of supporters from Ayr PS had made the long trip down to the event and were there to see Competition Secretary Roy Smith presented with the Club's 3rd placed medal. Congratulations!

Scottish PF Joint Winners of PAGB Mono Inter-Fed Competition 2025

This year the PAGB Inter-Federation Competition Judging was open again to Prints only with three Sections being Judged Colour, Mono and Nature where up to 20 prints per section could be submitted by each Federation, with the top scoring 15 counting to the overall Federation placing. The SPF again made their selection from prints entered into this year's SPF Print Championship. We are very grateful to the Clubs and Individual Photographers who gave us their work for these competitions.

The Judges for this event were Adrian Lines (L&CPU), Sue Sibley (SCPF) and David Smith (SPA). The Judging took place on the 21st June and was hosted by the Southern Counties PF. This year's results were as follows.

In the Mono Print competition, the SPF finished Joint 1st= with L&CPU with 178 pts and took two Individual awards, a Judge's Medal to 'Memories of Summer' by Ken Lindsay, Eastwood PS, and a PAGB Ribbon for 'Wreck Diver' by Ken Gillies, Edinburgh PS. A total of 9 Mono prints were accepted into the Exhibition; these are listed below.
