The SPF Print Championship judging was held on 17 February 2019 at Stirling Court Hotel. The Judges were - Colin Westgate FRPS MPAGB MFIAP APAGB and Chrissie Westgate FRPS, both from East Anglian Federation, with Gerald Chamberlin EFIAP DPAGB from Northern Counties Photo Federation. The prints were simultaneously judged and projected, to improve the audience viewing of the 1373 prints by 31 Clubs from all over Scotland (140 prints more than in 2018).







The quality of images were of such a high standard and as always, we thoroughly enjoyed the event.





Full details of the 96th Scottish Salon 2019 are now available on the Scottish Salon website. Patronage has again been granted by PSA and FIAP.

The 2019 Scottish Salon again has SIX Sections –

- **3 PRINT SECTIONS (Open Mono, Open Colour, Nature)** (500mmx400mm Max; Mounted or Unmounted) **AND**
- 3 PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGE SECTIONS (Open Mono, Open Colour, Nature) (1600x1200 pixels maximum, jpeg).

CLOSING DATE 4TH APR 2019

OVER 160 AWARDS will be presented in 2019, with PSA, FIAP, & SPF Medals, Ribbons and Certificates awarded. Free A4 paper Catalogue.

In addition there are awards for Scottish Salon 'Nature Photographer of the Year'.

SPECIAL AWARDS FOR SCOTTISH AUTHORS AND CLUBS

There is a Best Scottish Club Competition and Trophy to be won - Gold Medals for Best Scottish Resident in each Section. This is in addition to all of the other awards. You will automatically become eligible for all of the Salon awards when you submit an entry. You receive a high quality A4 Catalogue just for entering.

The reduced Entry Fees for Club entries of - £1.20 per print or projected digital image (PDI) - means if you only want to enter 1 print in each of the 6 sections you only pay £7.20. Clubs must enter a minimum of 25 photos to be eligible for this price. CLUB COLLATION FORMS FOR 2019 ARE NOW AVAILABLE TO SUPPLY TO YOUR MEMBERS from the SPF Website.

To be eligible for the cheaper Club entry Fee of £1.20 per photo, and to be eligible for the Scottish Club Award; one person from a Club has to organise and submit all of the entries in to our Online Entry via the Scottish Salon website - not the SPF website.

13th FIAP Clubs' World Cup 2018

BELFAST (NORTHERN IRELAND)

Eastwood PS entered the 13th FIAP World Cup for Clubs which was judged in Northern Ireland at the end of 2018. They achieved a fantastic result, coming 8th out of 188 clubs, and they were awarded an Honourable Mention. They finished ahead of some very big hitting UK Clubs, including Wigan 10, Chorley, Inn focus, Smethwick and the 2018 Champions, Catchlight CC. Rolls Royce (Derby) PS was the only UK club to finish ahead of them in 4th place.
