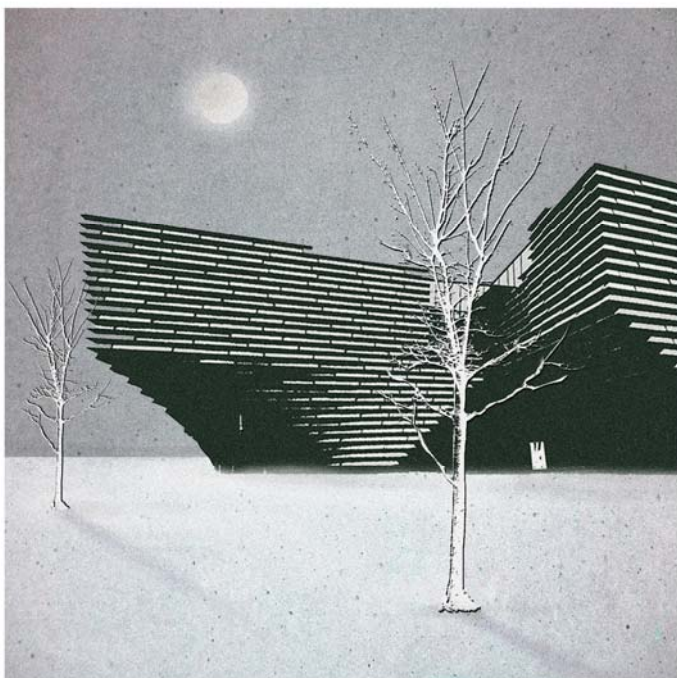




Although these pictures are entirely created in Photoshop they are not, of course, photographs.

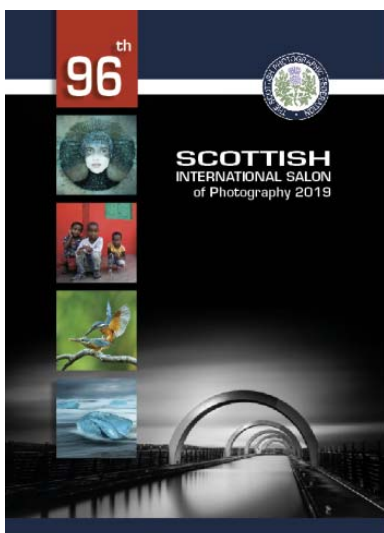

In the 50 years that have followed technology has advanced rapidly. Video cameras, and then digital cameras have appeared and, with computers and the internet, have revolutionised the way photographers work. Yet this strong trans-Atlantic relationship has endured and will hopefully continue for many years to come.

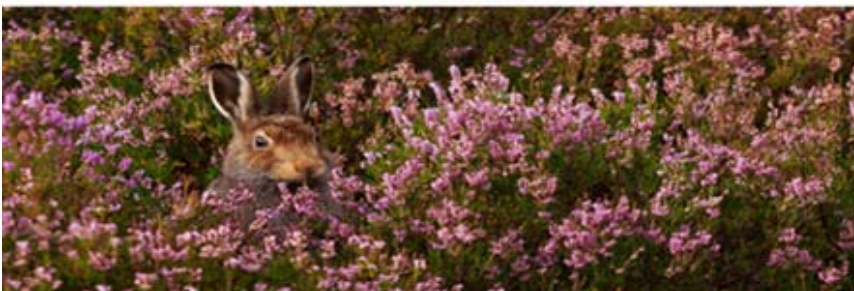

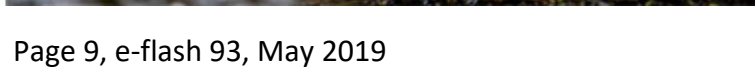
