The SPF have arranged this additional Workshop primarily for those who could not gain a space to have work assessed at the Jan 19 Workshop, spaces will then be on a first come, first served basis.

FREE ENTRY BUT MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE

Tea/Coffee will be available if pre-booked at a cost of £2.00 (Supplied at 9.30am)

Refreshments will be available to purchase at the premises, and nearby – no packed lunches in the premises please.

You require to email Libby if you wish to attend, with the details requested on the Form supplied, by 27th February after which the workshop will be thrown open to all Club Members - Please email even if you have contacted Libby previously, to confirm your booking and supply the below details. **You do not have a space until this is done.**

When booking a space please let us know ALL of the following (See Form) –

YOUR NAME AND CLUB; THE LEVEL YOU ARE GOING FOR; OBSERVE ONLY OR WISH WORK ASSESSED IF YOU HAVE APPLIED & FOR APR 19 OR NOV19 OR YOU HAVE NOT YET APPLIED

WHICH MEDIUM YOU WILL BE BRINGING - PRINTS OR PDI – PLEASE SEE GUIDANCE BELOW

Those considering applying for a PAGB Award for Photographic Merit in the future are also welcome to come along to have work assessed or as an Observer. **Observers must also book.**

If you are attending please read carefully what you can bring to this workshop.

The format of the day will be mainly to assess your work however we will have a short introductory period if we have a number of attendees new to the PAGB Awards. If you have already applied you can gain advice on any images you are not sure about, or perhaps suggestions where your 'quality' may be improved - e.g. areas requiring lightened/darkened/contrast/an alternative crop. Individuals experienced in the PAGB Awards requirements will be on hand to give feedback; We have two members of the PAGB APM subcommittee; Rod Wheelans MPAGB, Chairman of the PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit, and Libby Smith MPAGB there to give advice. Others will be joining them.

IF YOU ARE BRINGING PHOTOGRAPHS AND HAVE NOT YET APPLIED

You are advised to bring along 5 to 7 photos you think make up the basis for 'your strongest submission' – You can of course show 5 to 7 different photos to a different assessor on the day

IF YOU ARE BRINGING PHOTOGRAPHS AND YOU HAVE ALREADY APPLIED AND YOU HAD A FULL SET OF PHOTOS ASSESSED IN JAN 19 - You are also limited to bring along 5 to 7 photos per assessor

IF YOU ARE BRINGING PHOTOGRAPHS AND YOU HAVE ALREADY APPLIED BUT DID NOT HAVE YOUR FULL SET ASSESSED IN JAN 19 - You are advised to bring along the photos you think make up 'your strongest submission' - 10, 15 or 20 dependant on C, D or M level – You can bring an additional 5 photos to this number

Please do not present any more to the team assessing as it is unfair on the other candidates – this will be strictly adhered to - (If required you can show different photos to a different team of assessors) – For those of you who were not happy at a previous workshop – please bear in mind that MPAGB applicants require 20 prints so that means we assess 25!

You are advised that most of these photos should be, where possible, 'finished images' although prints do not need to be mounted, or A3. Image Quality and/or Printing skill will have a large bearing on whether or not you should use some images or indeed what they are likely to score, or what level you should go for.

Digital Files should be 1600x1200 max (1400x1050 continues to be acceptable) - jpeg or tiff files only please. Also, you are advised to bring along your images in the medium that you are entered, or likely to enter, in the adjudication i.e. do not bring 'digital files' if you intend entering in 'prints' - images do not necessarily work as well in both mediums and print quality cannot be seen on a digital file. – If you have not yet applied, and are not sure, please bring a sample of both adhering to the above quantities.
