EVENT 2 - PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit Presentation **SPF Event held on Zoom Monday 2nd Oct at 7pm.**

This PAGB run SPF event is being run for those interested in gaining PAGB Awards BPAGB, CPAGB, DPAGB, EPAGB, MPAGB. This is open to all SPF Club members and is FREE to attend. Loads of information, examples, and Q&A session.

This event suits individuals whether they are just thinking about possibly applying or if they have already applied for a forthcoming adjudication. This PAGB Presentation includes looking at a selection of images in the passing range at each level together with information of use for all three standards. We will also illustrate the differences in quality and requirements between the various levels, using examples of the same subject at both C, D and M. EVENT 3 - PAGB Awards Day by the PAGB for Print & PDIs **PAGB event being held at Dunblane on Saturday 18th Nov.**

This all-day 'face-to-face' FREE event is being run by the PAGB, and hosted by the SPF at Victoria Hall, Dunblane, starting at 10.00am. This PAGB format event will allow you to gain an overview of the PAGB system, with a presentation by the PAGB with four members of the PAGB Awards team present, including its Chairman, together with SPF assessors.

Individuals will have the opportunity to have prints or projected images assessed, as well as see a variety of prints in the passing range at C, D and M. This event suits individuals whether they are just thinking about possibly applying or if they have already applied for a forthcoming adjudication. This PAGB Presentation includes looking at a selection of images in the passing range at each level together with information of use for all three standards. EVENT 1 - SPF PAGB Awards Assessment Day for Print & PDIs being held at Dunblane on Sunday 17th Sept. BOOKING IS NOW OPEN.

This FREE all-day 'face-to-face' SPF event starting at 10.00am, and is being run at Victoria Hall, Dunblane, for individuals to have their prints and images assessed, so spaces require to be pre-booked as soon as possible. We can accommodate observers, but they also require to pre-book.

This SPF event will be run in the same format as our pre-covid events (and March 2023 event) where one-to-one feedback will be available from various assessors available on the day. You will be given allocated slots for the first assessment of each session, and then you can join the queue of whichever assessor you wish to get feedback from after that if you wish. Prints don't require to be mounted. PDI applicants will see their work projected.

The assessors who are attending, will include Rod Wheelans Chairman of the PAGB APMs & Libby Smith SPF Awards Officer. They will give you critique on your work with regard to the level you have applied for or are thinking of applying for in the same way as at our previous workshops. Tea/coffee making facilities will be available – bring your own packed lunch, or available from local vendors. *See Additional Venue Information for parking and location details*.
