SPF Rescheduled PAGB Awards Workshop Day for Assessment of Prints Only on Sat 7TH Mar '26

ONLY THOSE WHO ARE RECEIVING THIS PERSONAL INVITE DIRECT FROM LIBBY ARE ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND THIS SPF WORKSHOP.

This is an all-day FREE event starting at 10.00am, and being run at the United Reformed Church Hall, Carluke, for individuals to have prints only assessed.

Spaces require to be pre-booked as soon as possible but by 30th January at the latest. Please email Libby indicating your wish to attend stating your Name, Level of Award you have applied for please.

We do expect this workshop to be full well before this deadline, **the last was full in under 24 hrs!** so please submit info as soon as you know you are able to attend. We can only accommodate limited observers at this workshop, so **ALL observers must also pre-book by emailing Libby with a note of their Name.**

Spaces for this workshop will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, with everyone able to have up to 10 prints assessed per assessor (i.e. 20 different prints max if you wish).

I will acknowledge receipt of your booking email and confirm you have a space on this workshop, and I will supply full venue details at that time. The venue will open at 9.30am, and Tea/Coffee will be available shortly thereafter ready for the 10am start.

Only Prints will be assessed at this workshop given the volume of individuals who have already applied for Apr 2026 in prints. Prints do not require to be mounted. This event will be run in our normal format with stations of assessors giving critique on your work with regard to the level you have applied for or are thinking of applying for. You will be allocated two stations of assessors and time slots (one am and one pm), after that you can seek advice from anyone who is free at the end of each session. Tea/coffee making supplies will be available for a donation. Bring your own packed lunch, or available from local vendors within easy walking distance. The assessors who are attending, will include Rod Wheelans Chairman of the PAGB APMs & Libby Smith SPF's PAGB Awards Officer and PAGB APM Sub-Committee member, together with Neil Smith and Richard Speirs who attend every PAGB Awards Adjudication as part of the team.
