Your Club members are invited to submit an entry to the SPF Print Championship 2026. The Judging will take place on 15th February 2026 at Victoria Hall, Dunblane.

Online Closing Date 4th Feb 2026

All prints for the competition must be submitted to non-central belt drop-off points by 24th Jan 2026, for hand-over at our SPF EC meeting the following day, or to central belt drop-off points in time for final delivery direct to Carluke, by the final Close for receipt of prints by 7th Feb 2026, by post or hand-in.

Full details of drop-off points, available to you will appear on our website shortly. You are advised to contact your chosen drop-off point to make arrangements with them well in advance of your chosen drop-off time.

Online Entry will open early January.

- Online Entry via our website of all Print Titles and Author details
- No digital copies will be required.
- Mounted Prints only (max 500mm x 400mm)
- Only one person must collate and submit all entries from a club.
- Maximum 3 Mono Prints and 3 Colour Prints per author.
- Cost remains 70p per print.
- Maximum 80 prints per Club.
- Top 10 Mono and 10 Colour prints to count for the Overall top Club, with max 5 Nature prints allowed in the top 20 counting.
- All entries must comply with the Conditions of Entry Statement and competition Rules. Please remember that this now includes compliance with our 'Advice on What is Allowed when entering SPF Competitions' (including new Al guidance) Please see the latest version from the following SPF webpage https://www.scottish-photographic-federation.org/competitions-guidance
- Eligibility for Best Colour Club (10 prints) & Best Mono Club (10 prints)
- A printed copy of the online entry form that will be available after processing is complete. A
 copy of this must be submitted with your prints.
- Payment can be by 'BACS', cheque or PayPal. Cheques (made payable to 'SPF') can be included with your prints or sent direct to Libby Smith. For BACS or PayPal details please contact Libby directly or see covering email sent when we notified you details of this event.
- Please remember that all velcro must be removed from prints, and all sticky areas covered or cleaned.

Club secretaries are asked to collect and forward all their members' prints together. We ask for the club person collating the entries to supply their contact details, and address in case of any queries during processing, or return of prints. We do not need any information about the author other than their name. The fee for this year is **70p per print**. Club secretaries are asked to collect all monies from their members and forward it as **one payment**. **See payment options above**.

For the 2026 competition, the total number of entries is again restricted to 1200 prints. Please read the rules carefully for details. There is again no Beginner Section in the 2025 competition, although beginners are welcome to enter.
